# **Auxiliary Uniform Care Instructions:**

(For the lycra velvet/velour uniforms put into service 2016/2017)

Auxiliary members are given a clean uniform at the beginning of the band season. It is the Auxiliary member's responsibility to keep the uniform clean for each event.

#### **Alterations**

All alterations and repairs will be done for you by the designated person chosen by the Band Director/Uniform Committee Chairperson. Parents are <u>NOT</u> permitted to alter or repair the Auxiliary Uniforms on their own.

### Cleaning

Tunic/Pants/Dress – Stretch Velvet / Velour with Sequins

If mud splashes onto velvet, let it dry completely, THEN brush it off with a dry towel. Turn uniform inside out and <u>HAND WASH ONLY</u> in cold water & mild detergent. <u>DO NOT</u> soak. <u>DO NOT</u> wring or twist. Line Dry.

## Garment Bag Pompoms

Hand wipe with dish soap. Machine wash warm, dry on low heat.
